Performance Award Criteria

1. Only current CCSHA members and CCSHA Registered Horse combinations are eligible for the CCSHA Performance Award.
2. Performance Award Registration materials will be made available to all members through the CCSHA website, the CCSHA Newsletter and by writing to the CCSHA Awards Secretary.
3. The Performance Award will only be awarded after the CCSHA Awards Secretary receives correctly completed Performance records. E.g. the only points that will be counted towards Performance Award will be those signed by an organising club official or CCSHA executive member.
4. All Performance Award records will be PRINTED neatly ILLEGABLE records will not be accepted.
5. Records cannot be accepted with "White Out" corrections.
6. If Performance Records are lost or stolen please contact the CCSHA Awards Secretary for instruction.
7. The CCSHA member applying for award is responsible for the completion of all Performance Records.
8. Only after certification by the CCSHA Awards Secretary will the Performance Award be conferred on the CCSHA member.
9. CCSHA members are asked to complete event details on their Performance Records prior to securing signature of organising club.
10. If applicant combination is UNPLACED please write UNPLACED in Placing column.
11. One (1) class or event should be listed in each event record spacing e.g. Two Dressage tests will use two event record spaces and three dressage tests three spacings.
12. The number of points required to receive the CCSHA Performance Award will be 500
13. There will be no time limit on the achievement of the Performance Award; however the award will only be conferred on the applying combination once.
14. CCSHA organised events, State and National Titles in any equestrian discipline will receive double event points and double placing points.
15. Where event is made up of more than one equestrian activity (e.g. Horse Trials / Combined Training), ONLY the whole event is eligible for points. For Dressage each Test placing can be counted towards the Performance Award, no extra points can be awarded for event attendance or Jackpot placing.
16. In the equestrian discipline of SHOWING event points will be awarded for attendance at the event but PLACING points will only be counted for Champion and Reserve Champion Placings. *Please see points schedule.
17. The CCSHA Performance Awards will commence from the 1st of July 2006 and no back dating of Performance Records will be accepted.
18. The CCSHA committee reserve the right to refuse applicants and adjust the criteria at any time.
19. The CCSHA committee reserve the right to award the Performance Award to a CCSHA member who has shown remarkable persistence, patience and devotion to the CCSHA and or the Clydesdale Cross Sport Horse.
20. A ROLL of Performance Awards will be maintained by the CCSHA executive and published regularly on the CCSHA website and Newsletter.
